What types of services are provided?

- Blood Pressure Checks
- Cholesterol Screening
- Pregnancy Testing
- Screening for Diabetes
- Immunizations (*i.e. flu shot*)
- Hepatitis B
- Injection Administration (*such as B12*)
- Treatment for common urgent problems (*i.e. colds, flu, seasonal allergies*)
- Treatment for minor cuts, burns, sprains, contact dermatitis, urinary tract infections
- Massage Therapy
- Acupuncture
- Over-the-Counter Medications
- Prescription medications stocked in our pharmacy
- Referrals to outside providers

Convenient care is available to UNCG Faculty & Staff members as a service to the UNCG community. The goals of providing convenient care in the Gove Student Health Center are to assist UNCG employees with primary prevention and personal health maintenance by identifying existing health problems and offering convenient access to urgent care



Who is Eligible?

You must be a full-time or permanent part time UNCG employee. You must present your UNCG Identification card at the time of check-in to receive services.



Pharmacy Services

The pharmacy at Student health Services accepts the State Health Plan prescription drug coverage. Pharmacy can file with most insurance carriers.

Do I need an appointment?

To best serve your needs, Student Health Services requests that all interested faculty and staff make an appointment to receive services at the Student Health Center.

How do I pay for services?

Payment is due for services rendered at Student Health Services on the day of service. You may pay with cash, check, MasterCard or Visa.

You will be required at the time of your appointment to sign an agreement to pay for services. This agreement authorizes payroll deduction if charges are not paid for when they are rendered.
